Future Ready Schools® Institutes

Future Ready Micro-Credential – Empowering Students as Creators (Fall 2019)

Developed in partnership with Digital Promise, this micro-credential is a self-paced competency-based professional learning tool. With a focus on empowering students as creators, librarians engage in reflection, visioning, and providing artifacts of their teaching and work connected to student creation, making, and design. Evaluated by library leaders in the Lilead Project, librarians can submit their work and earn a micro-credential from Digital Promise and Future Ready Schools.

Future Ready Librarianship Course

Developed in partnership with ISTE, this course offers an online self-paced comprehensive exploration of the FRL Framework. This course is offered through ISTE-U and allows librarians to examine and reflect on their work in relation to the FRL framework in order to create a roadmap for library program development and personal professional learning.
